I am really pleased to be able to tell you that we are now in a position to go live and align to the new boundaries with an effective start date of 1st June 2022.

I'm sure you will agree that is really positive and welcome news.



WEEK OF ACTIONS

Op Sceptre – 16th May to 22nd May 2022.

Officers undertook multiple weapon sweeps across the ward. Positively no weapons were found.

What have we done in terms of priorities?

Burglary victims are all contacted by a member of the team and offered crime prevention advice. This is a continued commitment to our residents and victims of burglary. The team will also leaflet drop and knock on neighbouring properties to raise awareness and gather any information if available.

PCSO Barrett and Special Constable Kay on patrol discovered a moped that looked out of place on Kingsnympton Park Estate. After a few enquiries it was apparent the license plate was tampered with and that the real registration came back to a stolen bike. The owner was called and relieved to hear his bike had been found.

The team have been engaging with Kingston Hospital and are hopeful to hold a bike marking session on their grounds in the coming weeks so keep an eye out on our website for dates.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Friday 20th and Saturday 21st of May the team took part in a community stool in Kingston Town centre, giving out crime prevention, encouraging members of public to join the police and showcase some our specialist units, such as dogs, motorbike users.
