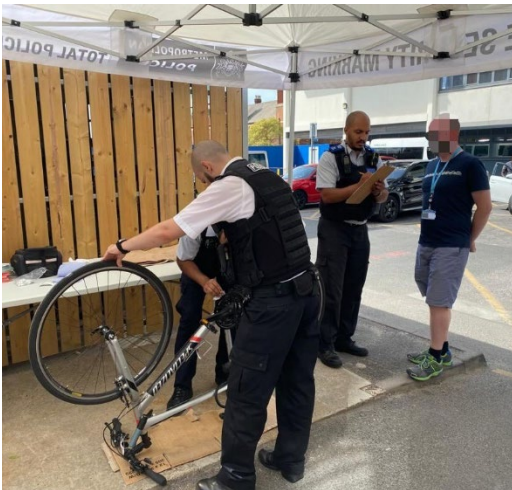

## What's been going on?

### **BIKE MARKING – KINGSTON HOSPITAL**



After a period of theft of pedal cycles on the Hospital site and around the ward, the team held a cycle marking event. This was helped by our colleagues in the Roads and Transport unit. Over 70 bikes were marked in the few hours we was in attendance, which was a really good turnout. The team are hoping to provide another soon while the weather is in our favour.

### **Summer Nights**

The dates have been set for 18th July – 4th Sept inclusive and 4 key strategic themes have been identified:

- Focus on reduction of violence against women and girls (VAWG)
- Increased activity around night time economy areas
- Serious youth violence
- Robbery reduction

The team have focused on areas such as Kingston University, Kingston Hospital, Kingsnympton Park Estate, Cumberland House to engage with woman and girls, youth and members of the public around safety and crime prevention.

### **Stop & Search**

6 youths were stopped in the vicinity of Elm Road and asked to account for why they were in the area. A strong Cannabis aroma was smelt by the Officers and they conducted searches. 3 of the youths were in possession of a small amount of Cannabis which resulted in 3 community resolutions.

### **Elm Road Rec Ground**

Following information received from the residents of Elm Road regarding young people utilising the recreation ground for ASB and drug use we partnered with RBK Council to get the bushes cut back, graffiti removed, broken glass and other materials cleaned up.

### What have we done in terms of priorities?

Burglary victims are all contacted by a member of the team and offered crime prevention advice. This is a continued commitment to our residents and victims of burglary. The team will also leaflet drop and knock on neighbouring properties to raise awareness and gather any information if available.

### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

From Monday 5th to 11th September the team will be a part in a community stool in Kingston Town centre, giving out crime prevention, encouraging members of public to join the police and showcase some of our specialist units, such as dogs, motorbike users.
